ORDER

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18.09.2026

1. Learned counsel appearing for the applicant submits that he be permitted to withdraw this application with further liberty to file afresh if the trial is not concluded within a reasonable period of time.
2. The Court finds that the application is in jail for more than two years and six months. The prosecution has already examined about 20 witnesses out of the total 32 witnesses.
3. The Investigating Officer [IO], who is present in Court, undertakes to render full cooperation in early completion of the trial. The IO shall not seek any adjournment on any pretext.



4. Bearing in mind the aforesaid aspects, the Court deems it appropriate to direct the concerned Court to conclude the trial within a period of six months from the date of receipt of a copy of the order passed today.
5. If the trial is not concluded within the same period, the applicant shall be at liberty to file an application which shall be considered on its own merit.
6. Application stands disposed of.
